As a part of faculty development & training beyond the regular academic inputs to students institute organised 2 SCR workshops (28 to 30th April 2023 and 8th to 10th September 2023) and 3 Symposiums (31st March, 1st & 2nd April 2023, 6 to 8th October 2023, and 16 to 18th Feb 2024) She also informed that all Part 1 students cleared exams conducted by MUHS. 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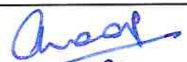
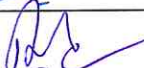
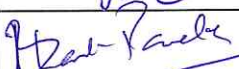
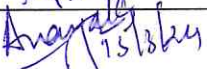
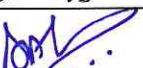
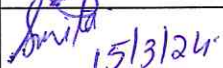
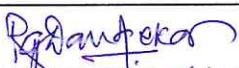
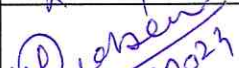
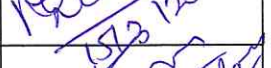
	research initiatives c) Central Council of Research in Homoeopathy, New Delhi for collaborative research. Dr Devadiga, Prof, Organon CMPHMC, Mumbai was invited for a guest talk on "Role of Homoeopathy in Surgical Cases" on the occasion of Hahnemann day celebration, dated 16th April 2023 Sh. Dandekar & Dr Gori expressed the need to offer short courses on nutrition, role of rehabilitation, yoga, personality building etc so that the students are oriented to marketplace need. Dr Bhavik shared a course on Critical thinking is being drafted. He also informed the SCR session being taken twice a week to update the students of the utility and benefit of the tool. Dr Bipin informed the course on nephrology too is being formulated. Dr Sunita shared the launch of series of webinars by the faculty from April 2024 on the book on psychology released by the trust recently, this will help the homoeopathic world on the way they can apply knowledge of psychology at bedside. RESEARCH: Dr Prashant Tamboli shared with the committee that most of the teaching faculty is now pursuing their PhDs from various institutes in India.	
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	6 research project were presented at "Avishkar" and event organized by MUHS (5th December 2023). 2 of these have now been selected for presentation at Research conclave at MUHS, Nashik. Institute has now entered, and MoU with St. John pharmacy college Meet in person this week. The proposal on research in hypertension in progress with Homoeopathy University Jaipur – Survey - Palghar and Vikramgad taluka for NCD along with surgical problem was organized and 5000 population was screened for prevalence assessment. Agriculture research centre Umroli was involved to share their expertise in 14 pilot project on Tulsi plant. Sh. Dandekar sought some more clarification on this project and was happy to note the effort of observing that if there is growth in plant i.e. homoeopathy as a fertilizer and improvement in yield. Dr Prashant shared these are placebo-controlled trials and aspects of germination speed and quality of seed is under assessment. Students of the institute are involved in these projects. Goshala veterinary research too on pilot basis is no and students are enrolled for the project. Pilot studies on introduction of medicine to improve quality of soil too is attempted at Umroli center. Sh Dandekar offered to help by his involvement in pilot studies and introduce the institute with Sh. Anil Patil farmer who is a Kisan Ratna award recipient, an award given by Government of Maharashtra to one	
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	farmer once in a year. Dr Prakash Gudsoorkar expressed his desire that we renew the old project of role of homoeopathy in fractures.
